Schneider Skate Park

Durango, CO: A portion of Schneider Skate Park will be going under construction to provide shade shelters, walkways, seat walls and a drinking fountain. Construction is scheduled to begin September 13, 2018 and continue until November 30, 2018. Construction will be limited to the north end of the park, not effecting the use of the skating facilities. The Animas River Trail spur access, adjacent to Schneider Skate Park, will be closed during weekdays to allow for construction activities. The parking lot at the intersection Roosa Avenue and El Paso Street will also be closed for the duration of construction.
