Lake Nighthorse First Annual Fishing Derby

Durango, CO: The City of Durango announces the First Annual Fishing Derby at Lake Nighthorse on Saturday October 13, 2018. Weigh-In to participate in the competition is from 12:00pm to 3:00pm at the Lake Nighthorse Boat Ramp. Everyone is welcome to enter this contest, and there is no event fee to participate. However, a Lake Nighthorse entrance pass is required. Junior Division includes anglers aged 15 and under. Senior Division includes anglers aged 16 and up. Prizes will be awarded for the following categories: 1st, 2nd, 3rd for total weight and BIG FISH for each division.

Rainbow Trout, Brown Trout, and Kokanee Salmon have been stocked by Colorado Parks and Wildlife (CPW) since 2011. Fishing regulations are as follows:

- Valid State of Colorado fishing license required for anglers over 15 years of age
- Bag limit is 4 trout per day
- Anglers can use traditional baits (see Colorado Parks and Wildlife Fishing Brochure for definitions, e.g., no aquatic live bait allowed)
- Limit on Kokanee Salmon is 10 per day, no snagging
- No fishing around the boat ramp
- Please put fish entrails in the garbage, not the lake
