Oxbow Park and Preserve Closed Until Further Notice

Durango, CO: The City of Durango's Parks and Recreation Department has closed access to Oxbow Park and Preserve (500 Animas View Drive). The beach area at Oxbow Park and portions of the Oxbow Preserve are flooded due to the rising water levels on the Animas River. To protect this resource and minimize damage to the existing trails, Oxbow Park and Preserve will remain closed until the water level has receded and the trails within the Preserve have dried out.
