

Parking Fines

- The City of Durango encourages prompt payment of parking fines by increasing the initial fine if it is not paid within 7 days.
- The fine increases again at the end of 28 days. Please pay any parking fine promptly to avoid escalation of the fine.

Common Parking Violations/Fines

- Overtime at meter: \$12 / \$24 / \$48
- Not Wholly in Space: \$15 / \$30 / \$60
- Parking in a Green Zone: \$50 / \$100 / \$200
- Parking in a Yellow Zone: \$15 / \$30 / \$60
- Parking in a Red Zone: \$25 / \$50 / \$100
- Parking in CBD between 2am and 5am: \$15 / \$30 / \$60

Bicycle/Pedestrian Information



- Bicycle parking is directed toward bike racks located along most downtown streets, including parking-meter-post bike racks. Covered and lit bicycle parking is located at the Transit Center.
- Colorado State Law requires motorists to yield to pedestrians in crosswalks.

3 & 10 hour meters: 75 cents for
60 minutes

Main Avenue - 5th St. to 12th St.

3 & 10 Hour Meters: \$1.00 for 60 minutes
30 minute meters: 50 cents for 30 minute

FAQs



- Parking is not allowed at onstreet meters from 2 am to 5 am
- “DSNG” Train Station (970) 247-2733. Opens: Summer 7am, Winter 8am
- The Durango Welcome Center at 8th St. and Main is open daily from 9am - 6pm. Extended evening hours Mon-Sat during summer. 970-247-3500
- Parking is allowed in City lots 5pm - 7am (without a permit) All Sat. & Sun.
- Oversized vehicle parking (OSV) is allowed on 5th St. between 2nd and 3rd Ave. and Roosa Ave south of 9th St. (See Map)
- Train Parking is available in their lot on College for \$7 per day for cars and \$9 per day for buses and RVs
- Limited Motorcycle spaces are available at 3 locations in the 900 and 1000 blocks of Main Avenue (See Map)


