

# Skyline Trailhead Construction

## What is happening at the Skyline Trailhead?

The City of Durango Parks and Recreation Department is making parking, drainage and landscape improvements to the existing trailhead parking area for the Skyline Trail at the north end of Jenkins Ranch Road. The project involves the creation of a defined area for head-in parking utilizing a permeable paved surface, concrete curb/gutter and sidewalk to replace the poorly draining existing parking area. Also included in the project is installation of drainage infrastructure within the street right-of-way and completion of restorative landscape seeding and mulching.

Skyline Trail access from Jenkins Ranch Road will be closed on **Wednesday June 28<sup>th</sup> and Thursday June 29<sup>th</sup>**. Access to Skyline Trail can be made following the private drive, just north of the work zone. **Please be mindful this is temporary access on private property.** Thank you for your patience while we make improvements to the trail system.
