What's your vision for getting around Durango? Next neighborhood meeting is Aug. 2

Durango, CO: Is it difficult to get around Durango without a car? Could your neighborhood be more walkable or accessible? How can Durango's transportation network be more equitable? The city is updating the Multimodal Transportation Plan and wants your feedback on how Durango's transportation network could be improved.

The plan is updated every four years to address changing multimodal transportation needs in the community. The city is conducting neighborhood meetings and other outreach this year to gather residents' input. Community members are invited to attend the next neighborhood meeting on **Monday, August 2, from 4 to 6 p.m.** in the Animas Room at the La Plata County Fairgrounds, 2500 Main Ave.

"Community input is important in this process," said Devin King, multimodal administrator. "We encourage residents to attend a neighborhood meeting and go to our website for other ways to provide feedback on how Durango's transportation network can be more accessible and safer for everyone."
